


Beta Alpha Psi Membership Requirements



General Membership Requirements

<u>GPA:</u>

• Beta Alpha Psi requires its members to maintain a 3.3 GPA or above for both major *and* overall GPA.

<u>Majors:</u>

- Accounting
- Finance
- Information Systems
- MAcc
- MBA

Dues:

- Affiliate: \$25 per semester
- Candidate: \$100 per academic year*
- Member: \$50 per academic year* (\$25 per semester)

*An academic year is defined as two semesters (Fall 2021 & Spring 2022)





Students enrolled in 2000 or 3000 level classes are considered "Affiliates" of Beta Alpha Psi. This designation allows students to explore how the organization may align with their interests

Engagement Requirements:

- Professional Hours: 6
 - All from BAP Meetings
- Service Hours: 6



Candidate

Students enrolled in 5000-level classes are considered "candidates" for membership. This designation allows students to further opportunities while working towards becoming an inducted member of Beta Alpha Psi.

Requirements:

- Professional Hours: 12
 - Meetings Required: 9*
- Service Hours: 12**
- Social Events: 2
- Initiation Banquet: YES
- Committee: YES

* Meeting attendance counts as professional hours.

** 5 service hours can be from approved outside service



Member (Distinguished & Superior)

After completing candidate requirements and attending the Initiation Banquet in a single semester, students become members of Beta Alpha Psi. Members often experience personal and professional growth as they connect to a national network of students and professionals..

Member Requirements:

- Professional Hours: 12
 - Meetings Required: 9*
- Service Hours: 12
- Social Events: 2

Distinguished & Superior Member Requirements:

- Professional Hours: 15 & 20
 - Meetings Required: 9* & 10*
- Service Hours: 15 & 20
- Social Events: 3
- Initiation Banquet: YES

*Meeting attendance counts as professional hours.




Service
